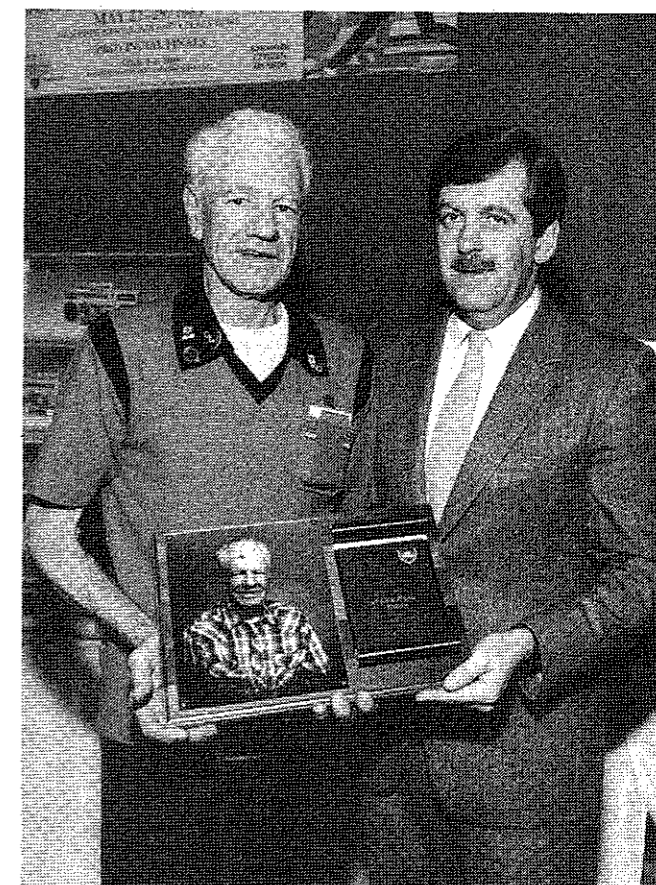

WEST CONTINUES TO DOMINATE CBC 5 PIN BOWLING COVERAGE



Once again, 5 Pin Bowling's top prize \$10,000.00 has stayed in Western Canada. In the final game, Russel Hunt of Victoria, British Columbia built an early lead and coasted to a 247-200 victory over the 1985 Canadian OV OPEN Champion Nick DiVirgilio of Thompson, Manitoba. DiVirgilio reached the final in a rematch victory of last year's OV OPEN in St. John's, Newfoundland. Once again, the Manitoba kegler defeated Ray Cunningham of Calgary 210-204. Hunt's victory also guarantees a return visit to next year's show when the first prize may be as high as \$25,000.00.

Our Ontario representatives had their share of misfortune. Guelph's John Wilson was in the first match of the series and lost to Hunt 218-162.

The 1985 OV OPEN Champion, Bill Korz of Owen Sound faced better. The smooth stroking left hander from Owen Sound defeated Gerry Dooley of St. John's, Newfoundland 276-251 before losing to Cunningham 238-220 in week two of the series. Bill Korz is ceded back to this year's singles here in Hamilton and naturally hopes for victory and a return trip to the show!

All indications are that the bowling show will return next season. You can be sure that negotiations between the Bowling Proprietors' Association of Canada and the CBC include the possibility of more televised shows, the inclusion of a separate women's competition and even some exposure of 5 Pin's very large youth programme. At this time, while we do not know the outcome of these negotiations, everyone should take the time to write the CBC to express their appreciation for this year's show and a request for more next season.
