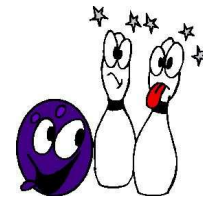

The day starts at 8:30 am with pictures of the teams usually with Jerry Howarth, who comes down to volunteer his time. The MBA chooses the teams randomly on the Saturday evening prior to the event at Bowlerama West. The day consists of four (4) games with a lunch break around noon, usually winding up around 3:30 pm. It is a long but very rewarding day.

This year the MBA are offering 14 spots (one for each Zone) to the O5. The cost to enter is \$75.00, and there is a dress code of black dress pants and an MBAO shirt. For the members of O5 any O5 Zone shirt would be acceptable. They want to ensure that if they go outside of their membership base for this event they only offer it to folks who are members of the O5.

Ladies High 5 Games

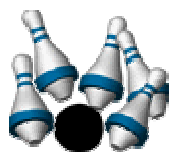

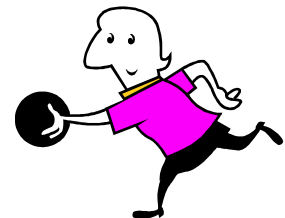
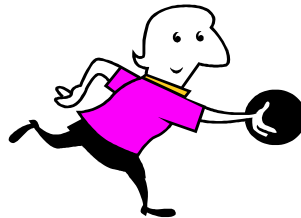
